

Getting started


(A) Unpacking and inspecting the delivery content



- Base station (DECT) | Charging cradle
- 2. Headset
- 3. Earbuds (4 ×)
- 4. Earhooks (4 ×)
- 5. Headband

- 6. Neckband
- 7. Power adapter
- 8. 2×1.8 m USB-A to USB-C cable
- 9. Phone headset adapter: RJ45-8P4C to RJ9-4P4C cable
- 10. EHS adapter#1: RJ12-6P6C to RJ12-6P6C cable
- 11. EHS adapter#2: RJ12-6P6C to 4-pin cable
- 12. Safety instructions (GPSR)


(B) Interfaces and connections



- 1. 2 × USB-C sockets
 - #1 (Adaptor): USB powering → see **D-1**
 - #2 (PC): PC connectivity → see E-1
- 2. RJ12-4P4C socket (EHS) \rightarrow EHS adapter
 - #1: EHS connectivity → see E-2
 - #2: EHS#2 connectivity → see **E-3**
- 3. RJ45-8P4C socket (PHONE) \rightarrow Phone headset adapter
 - RJ45-8P4C to RJ9-4P4C cable → see **E-2/3**



(C) Getting to know the A170C components → Base station (DECT) / Headset



- 1. Mute status indication: 1 red LED
- 2. Function key: Phone (with green LED)
- 3. Function key (PC): PC (with green LED)
- 4. Function key (PAIR): DECT pairing
- 5. Function key (*MICROPHONE*): Microphone volume + / (rocker)
- Function key (VOL + / VOL -): Volume + / miniature control stick
- 7. Function key: Onhook / offhook (with multicolour LED)
- 8. Function key (*MUTE*): **Muting and unmuting the**microphone → see C-1
- 9. Headset speaker
- 10. Microphone

- 11. Battery compartment → Battery, preinstalled, non-removable
- 12. Auto-answer switch (AutoAns)
 - *ON*: Answer phone by removing headset from charging cradle
- 13. Bandwidth switch
 - NB: Narrowband calls
 - WB: Wideband calls
- 14. Sound quality switch
 - A: Snom desk phone (D1xx, D3xx, D7xx, D8xx)
 - *B, C, D, E, F*: For other brands, try different settings until the sound is clear.
- 15. Charging cradle: Magnetic charging mount



Preparing the A170C for use


(D) Connecting / Charging the battery

- 1. Insert the USB-A connector into the power adapter and the USB-C connector into the *Adaptor* socket on the base station.
- 2. Plug the USB power adapter into a wall outlet and place the headset onto the charging mount of the

base station. The LED on the headset lights up (red: 0 to 50 % orange: 50 to < 100%, green: 100%), indicating that the handset is charging.

(E) Connecting the A170C to a Snom phone

Connect the A170C to a Snom phone or computer. Use the supplied cables as shown in the following illustration.



- 1. Use this option if you want to connect the A170C either as a headset for a telephony software solution on your computer or directly to your Snom desk phone via a free USB port. → Snom D3xx, D7x5, D7x7, D8xx
- 2. This option allows you to connect the A170C with full functionality to current and discontinued D7xx desk phones. \rightarrow Snom D715 \rightarrow proprietary 4-pin socket
- 3. If your Snom desk phone does not have a USB port or does not have a free one, use this option. \rightarrow Snom D140, D150, D3xx, D713, D717, D735, D78x, D8xx \rightarrow RJ12 socket



Putting the A170C into operation

Once the battery is fully charged and all cables are connected, the A170C is ready for use. If using the A170C with a Snom desk phone, activate headset mode on that device.

Snom 1xx, 3xx, 7xx: press

Using the A170C

(F) Choose one of the three wearing options



Three wearing styles:

- 1. over-the-ear \rightarrow see **A-4**
- 2. neckband → see A-6
- 3. over-the-head \rightarrow see **A-5**

(G) Call control, mute and volume control functions

- Switching the audio connection:
 - Press the button C-2 if you connected the Snom phone using the cables A-9 + A-10/11. Has a green LED that lights up when and as long as the mode is activated
 - If you connected your Snom phone or computer using the USB cable, press the button C-3. Has a green LED that lights up when and as long as the mode is activated
- Making calls Press 1 × C-7 and on the phone enter the number to dial and confirm.
- Accepting calls With an incoming call ringing, press
 1 × C-7.
- Terminating calls Press 1 × C-7.
- Muting and unmuting the microphone Press 1 × C Has a red LED that lights up when and as long as the microphone is muted.
- Adjusting the volume when in call Press C-6 +/-.
- Adjusting the microphone volume Press C-5 +/-.
